## **Essential functions of job: AFM**

- Review Schematics, BOMs and Layouts for design integrity and cost effectiveness.
- Work with supplier and design group to specify user interface functions and generate user interface documentation
- Work with mechanical design staff to optimize layouts for manufacturability and ease of use.
- Review and approve production capabilities of suppliers.
- Perform validation testing and evaluation/debugging of new products.
- Troubleshoot and repair electrical circuits at the component level.
- Provide technical support and training to Stillwater Designs technical writers and support staff.
- Provides Test and Validation support at the factory level
- Audits and validates factory level production processes

- Create and maintain vehicle test procedures and processes for the techs to use in vehicle
- Review Tunes and testing information to make sure its complete and correct for each application
- Identify Test requirements then develop effective test procedures/ specifications for the OEM install bay
